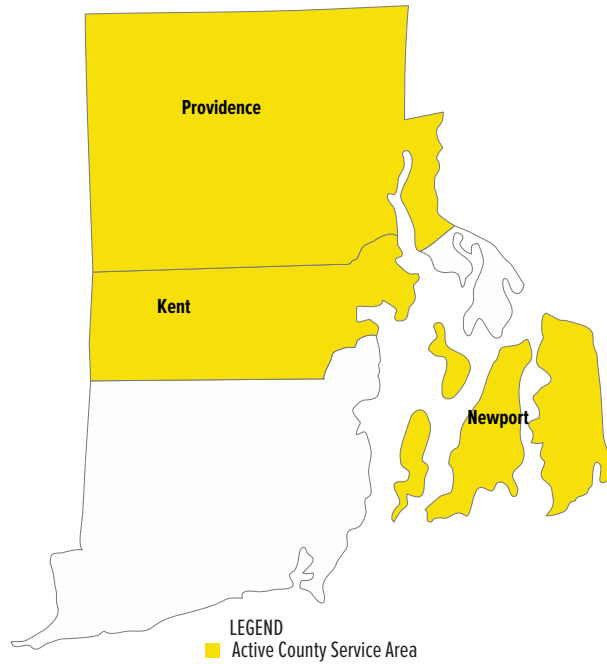
97% BABIES RECEIVED ALL IMMUNIZATIONS BY 24 MONTHS

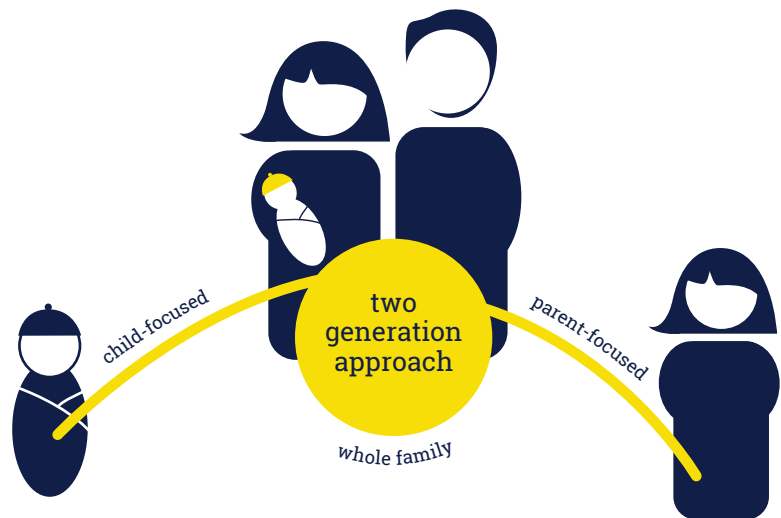
